1. Summarize your experience with and interest in our organization.

I have been involved in LGBT issues and campaigns for the past 15 years, including three years as then Mayor Gavin Newsom’s LGBT Advisor and Community Liaison. During my time on the Stonewall board, I have focused on external affairs, helping to organize the annual pride breakfast and served as the club’s liaison with elected officials. I am also representing the club on the Alameda County Democratic Central Committee as an Associate Member.
