Using specific examples, please identify the causes you have advocated for and the ways you have helped advance LGBTQ+ rights or otherwise helped foster a community of inclusivity for LGBTQ+ individuals and families.

I've been an advocate for the LGBTQ+ community my entire life. I grew up in segregated Texas and my mother's best friend was a lesbian. My mother taught us to never disrespect or let anyone else disrespect her friend for who she loved. In the Assembly, I wrote the California Schools Hate Violence Reduction Act that included protections for LGBTQ+ students and a republican governor signed into law. When elected to Congress, I co-founded the LGBTQ+ Equality Caucus and, as its chair, brought the Congressional Black Caucus on board in support of the Matthew Shepard and James Byrd Jr. Hate Crimes Prevention Act. I will always lift up the voices of the LGBTQ+ community and fight to protect the many hard earned rights.

Have you previously supported LGBTQ+ candidates for office? If yes, did that include financial support?

I have worked to elect a variety of LGBTQ+ candidates over the years. This work has included fundraising, organizing, and vigorously campaigning for candidates.

I'm proud of the work we've done to lead to what I hope will be the first AIDS free generation. I look to continue to pursue this work in the United States Senate. When I got to Congress I worked with a Republican President to establish and implement the President's Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief, or PEPFAR to assist developing countries in the treatment of HIV, AIDS, tuberculosis, and malaria with the goal of eventual eradication. And in 2011, I founded the Congressional HIV/AIDS Caucus to eradicate HIV/AIDS worldwide, educate the public, and improve the lives of those affected by HIV and AIDS which I continue to co-chair today.

What makes you uniquely qualified for the office and how are you different or unique from the other candidates in your race?

I have been fighting for justice and equity from the very start. From organizing with the NAACP to becoming my high school's first Black female cheerleader to standing my ground as the only member of Congress who voted against giving the president unlimited war powers after 9/11, I never back down from fighting for what's right. Throughout my career, I have fought to ensure equality for all. As a founding member and Vice Chair of the Congressional LGBTQ+ Equality Caucus, I have done the work to pass legislation that respects the love and dignity of all people.
